Read Marco's experience and see what you think**

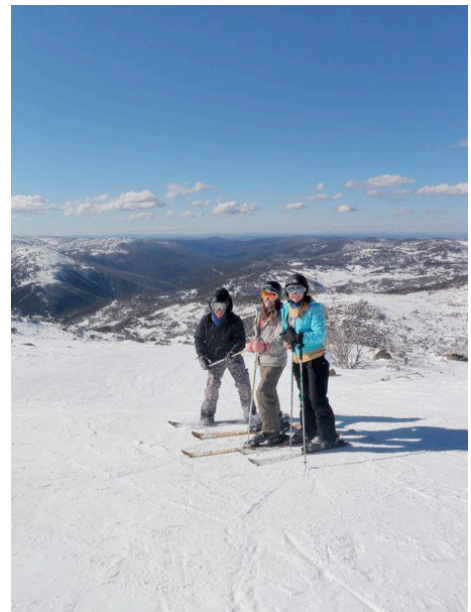
